CFP Innovation Fund Criteria for Grant Applications

To be considered for an Innovation Fund grant, you must be a pharmacist engaged in research or an innovative model of pharmacy practice that seeks to advance the profession in ways that can demonstrably improve the health of patients. CFP awards up to \$150,000 in total funding for grants per year. The submission process begins in Spring. Please note this is an online process that occurs in three stages:

Stage 1 - Letter of Intent

Please complete and submit the **Letter of Intent form**, usually due in May.

Stage 2 - Selection of Finalists

CFP's Board reviews the Letters of Intent and selects finalists in June. Finalists are asked to send a full application by the end of July.

Stage 3 - Selection of Grant Recipients

CFP's Grants Review Committee reviews the finalists' applications and makes its recommendations for funding in October. The Board selects and notifies the winners.
