



In June 2010, the pharmacy profession lost an exceptional leader and beloved colleague with the passing of Barbara A. Wells (1954-2010). Inspired by her contribution to the profession of pharmacy, the Canadian Foundation for Pharmacy instituted the Wellspring Pharmacy Leadership Awards to continue her legacy by fostering personal leadership development in the pharmacy community.

This annual award recognizes demonstrated and potential leadership in pharmacy. The cash award allows recipients to develop personal leadership through study, experiential learning or mentorship.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Pharmacists from all walks of pharmacy who are:

- Registered and in good standing within their community of practice.
- Recognized among their peers as being leaders or having leadership potential.
- Have a desire to enhance their knowledge and experience within the profession.
- Willing to share their experience and learning after their funding.

#### **APPLICATION CRITERIA**

- Amount of funds requested
- Purpose for the funding
- Recommendations from superiors or experts within their communities of practice for both the individual and the learning experience
- Expectations of learning from the experience
- Plans to disseminate experience and utilize their knowledge
- A description of how the pharmacist will expand their contribution to their professional practice as a result of the funding.
- A willingness to share their experience and learning after their funding

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- Applicants may submit for themselves or may nominate other deserving individuals.
- Grants will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing committee.
- Grants will be awarded in amounts of ranging from \$1,000 to \$10,000 to selected applicants.
- Applications in any amount are welcome, up to a total of \$10,000 (maximum) annually.
