## Pillar of Pharmacy Award

The Pillar of Pharmacy Award recognizes the ongoing commitment of a person to the practice of pharmacy and the advancement of the profession and/or pharmacy sector. Key considerations include leadership, dedication, service and influence.

### Criteria for Selection

The candidate must demonstrate:

- An ongoing commitment to and leadership in the practice of pharmacy.
- Contributions with a significant impact on the pharmacy profession and/or sector.
- An inspirational and influential voice in the pharmacy sector.
- Volunteer work in various capacities at local, national, or international levels to create awareness and advance the pharmacy profession, outside of their usual practice site or job.
- Active involvement in one of the four disciplines represented on the CFP Board (community pharmacy, academic pharmacy, pharmaceutical industry, pharmacy associations).
- They are not currently, nor have been, a Board member or an employee of the Canadian Foundation for Pharmacy for three years prior to their nomination.

### Nomination Process

- Normally awarded to one person annually.
- Anyone can nominate (includes self-nomination).
- Nomination should include:
  - Resumé, CV or a brief biography.
  - Description of how the nominee has demonstrated leadership and innovation in the profession.
  - Outline of their activities and efforts (e.g., membership on committees, volunteer work, advocacy, etc.) that have contributed to the advancement of the profession.
  - Specific examples of their overall impact on the profession locally, provincially, nationally or internationally.
