## **CFP Innovation Fund Criteria for Grant Applications**

To be considered for an Innovation Fund grant, you must be a pharmacist engaged in research or innovation in pharmacy practice that seeks to advance the profession in ways that can demonstrably improve the health of patients.

In 2025, CFP will award up to \$150,000 in total funding.

New this year: \$50,000 of the Fund is earmarked for shorter-duration initiatives of up to one year. These initiatives seek to “move the needle” in community pharmacy in the areas of practice change and improvements in patient care. Each shorter-duration initiative is eligible for up to \$10,000 in funding.

The online submission process occurs in three stages:

### **Stage 1 - Letter of Intent**

Complete and submit the **Letter of Intent** form @ <https://www.nominatenow.ca/myawards/cfp>

The deadline is April 15, 2025.

### **Stage 2 - Selection of Finalists**

CFP’s Board reviews the Letters of Intent and selects finalists in June. Finalists are asked to submit their full application online by the end of July.

### **Stage 3 - Selection of Grant Recipients**

CFP’s Grants Review Committee reviews the finalists’ applications and makes its recommendations for funding in October. The Board selects and notifies the grant recipients.
